If you are hurt at work it is comforting to know that you have insurance coverage. The Workers Compensation Board (WCB) provides you and your employer with insurance coverage offering a range of medical and compensation benefits.

As an employee, you have no-fault injury insurance, paid for by your employer. The program provides excellent benefits to workers while offering valuable protection to employers.

The WCB administers the workers compensation program and is committed to providing quality service that is fast, easy, caring, right and clear.

## Workers Compensation Coverage Benefits Workers

Work shouldn't hurt. But if you get injured at work, first seek healthcare attention and report your injury to your employer. Upon acceptance of your claim you may be eligible for a range of benefits that could include:

- wage replacement,
- healthcare treatments,
- rehabilitation services,
- payment of medication costs,
- employment retraining,
- lump sum payments for permanent impairments and payments to spouses, common-law partners and children in the event of a workplace death.

Our goal is to help injured workers return to health and meaningful work as soon as possible. When returning to work, you will work with your employer, healthcare provider and possibly a WCB representative to develop a plan that supports your safe return to the workplace.

## About the Workers Compensation System

The workers compensation system is a no-fault injury and disability insurance system for workers and employers, paid for by employers.

WCB coverage provides advantages for both Manitoba employers and workers. Employers receive protection from lawsuits from workers injured on the job, while injured workers receive a full range of benefits such as wage replacement, healthcare treatments and much more with no waiting period.

Working with its partners, the WCB promotes safe and healthy work places, recovery and return to meaningful work, and provides compassionate and supportive compensation services to Manitobans.
